



Core Program Process Overview






Project Status: Capital Pipeline *Active Projects*

What is collective or collaborative purchasing?

- As stated in The Chapter 30B Manual: Procuring Supplies, Services and Real Property...
- Chapter 30B and M.G.L. c. 7, § 22B, authorizes two or more local jurisdictions to solicit bids for supplies or services as a group.
- This procurement method authorizes one local jurisdiction, called "the lead jurisdiction," to procure supplies and services and award a contract for the benefit of a designated group.
- The lead jurisdiction would undertake the bid process in full compliance with Chapter 30B, and each participating local jurisdiction must accept sole responsibility for payment fro any purchases that it elects to make under the contract and for compliance with all legal requirements governing administration of the contract.




